

School will:

- Support learning at school and at home by supporting the completion and return of homework and through reading with your children at home (at least 4 times weekly with Key Stage 1 children and continued regular opportunities for the older children).
- Participate in dialogue concerning child's progress and behaviour.

Children will:

- Do their best, with support and encouragement, to model the school rules and values of being ready, respectful, responsible, resilient and reflective.
- Keep the agreed class and school rules.
