Harvest Festival

School will be holding our annual Harvest Festival on Tuesday 1st October at 9am and all parents/carers are invited to attend. We will be collecting donations of non-perishable foods and toiletry items from Wednesday 25th September. These can be taken down to the school hall at the beginning or end of the day or when dropping off or collecting from breakfast/after-school club. The last opportunity to donate will be at the end of the day on Monday 30th September.

These donated food items and toiletries will be taken to Wallingford Food Bank following the service on October 1st. The food bank ask that all donations have a use by or best before date that is at least 3 months away. Thank you in advance for your support, I have always been very impressed and grateful for your generosity in the past.

Pick-up arrangements

Please make sure you let the school know if someone who has never picked up from school before, or someone who does not normally do so, will be collecting your child at the end of the day. If there is an unexpected change of person collecting then please let the school office know about this change of plan so that staff and your child are aware. This helps make matching up the children with the correct adult at the end of the day easier and quicker and eliminates any confusion or uncertainty.
